## **Daily Guest Rules and Regulations!**

Thank You for choosing Sand Haven Campground. We hope you enjoy your stay. If you have any questions or concerns, please let us know.

All special events and activities will be posted in the Haven Lodge.

You are expected to follow all rules and regulations as posted on your rental agreement, on this page and throughout the campground. If you would like a copy of the rules and regulations you signed upon check-in, please ask.

We are a family campground and will be operated accordingly.

**Campsites Rates** are based on 1 camping unit, 1 adult and their legal dependents or up to 6 adults. Anyone who is over the age of 18 and is not a legal dependent is considered a guest in which additional fees may apply. Campsites cannot exceed 6 persons.

Tents are not allowed at any campsite. Your camping unit must have a working bathroom.

**Parking:** Campsites are allowed 1 vehicle per site. Extra vehicles and trailers must be parked in the additional parking areas. No vehicles or trailers can be parked in common areas or other sites. No blocking/parking on roadways.

All campers and guests MUST check in at the Lodge upon arrival. This Is The LAW! Check-in is allowed after 2pm and checkout is by 11am. There is no parking for camping units after sunset.

**The shower house** is for all to use. Please clean up after yourself and let us know if anything needs attention.

**Restrooms in the Haven** are open 24 hrs. When the Haven is closed you can access the restrooms from the outside of the building.

**The Pond:** There is no lifeguard on duty, and you are swimming at your own risk. Children under the age of 13 must always be supervised by an adult. Please read all rules posted at the Pond. Pond hours are 10am to 8pm (or dusk) Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend (weather dependent). The pond will be closed during inclement weather and when lightning and thunder are detected in the area.

**Playground:** Children under the age of 13 years old should always be supervised. All children should be off the playground and back at their sites by 11:00PM. We are not responsible for injuries or accidents. CAMPER specifically acknowledges and will abide by the rules posted at the playground.

Respect: Racism, ethnic slurs, comments directed at the appearance, sexual orientation or characteristics of others are unacceptable and you will be removed from the CAMPGROUND. Camping is for all people. If you aren't ready to welcome anyone else, we're not ready to welcome you.

Inappropriate Displays of Affection will not be tolerated, and you will be removed from the CAMPGROUND.

**Speed Limit: 5mph max.** This will be strictly enforced. Only electric golf carts are allowed.

## Fireworks and Drones are not allowed.

**Campfires** are allowed in designated areas (fire rings) only. No moving of fire rings. Fires are never to be left unattended and make sure your fire is completely doused at the end of the night. You are responsible for any damage your fire may cause.

**Firewood** can be purchased from the Lodge by 7pm. There are no deliveries of firewood after dark.

**Quiet Hours:** Will be strictly enforced between 11pm and 8am. Music and conversations are allowed at your campsite as long as it does not offend your neighbors. All guests must be at a campsite between these hours.

**Smoking:** is not allowed in any common areas such as but not limited to the Lodge, Swim Pond, Bath House, Restrooms, Playground and other shared amenities.

No Outdoor Rugs Allowed on Daily Campsites.

Do Not Move Picnic Tables from Site To Site.

**Trash:** Dispose of all trash in proper locations. There are 2 dumpsters at the entrance/exit of the campground. All garbage must be tied in plastic bags. No fish or raw meat allowed in the dumpsters. No littering allowed.

Any person, adult or child, found stealing, damaging property or any other illegal activity will be evicted immediately. No Exceptions! Parents are responsible for their children's behavior.

We reserve the right to refuse to admit anyone for any reason, or to remove anyone who is behaving in a manner which is unacceptable.

Emergency dial 911 or use the red phone at the swim pond. Then Please call 715-967-2067 and notify the Campground.

**Severe Weather:** There is not a storm shelter on site, and you are camping at your own risk. Local radio stations for weather alerts are 99.1 Rice Lake and 104.5 Eau Claire.
