



RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) For Seasonal Campers move-ins are allowed after 12:00 noon on the move-in date and upon receipt of required fees.
- 2) For Daily Campers move-ins are allowed at 2PM on the reservation date. Check out is at 11AM on the departure date.
- 3) All comments concerns and repair requests must be submitted to Sand Haven Campground in writing.
- 4) Smoking is not allowed in the common areas, which include bathhouses, restrooms, the swimming pond, and laundry rooms.
- 5) No washing of cars or boats is allowed. Washing of RV's is permitted Sunday at noon through Thursday at noon.
- 6) Camper(s) and their guests are expected to conduct themselves in a manner befitting respectable living. Overindulgence in alcoholic beverages, loud boisterous parties, disorderly conduct, or any criminal activity on or off premises will be grounds for immediate removal. Camper(s) are responsible for their guests' actions.
- 7) Quiet time at Sand Haven Campground is from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
- 8) Should Camper(s) be absence from the Campsite for more than two weeks, or if the Camping Unit is being removed from the Campsite, Sand Haven Campground must be notified in writing of absence dates. If notice is not given Sand Haven Campground may report a Camping Unit stolen or declare a Campsite abandoned.
- 9) Bicycles, scooters (electric or non-motorized), hoverboards, and any other pedal vehicle may be used in the campground during daylight hours. They must be equipped with a white light on the front and red light on the back for nighttime use. Reflectors are recommended.
- 10) Visitors who add a tent to a Campsite must pay the normal tent camping rates for the days they stay. No tents are allowed in sites that are 30' or 35' x 65' when a camping unit is already there.
- 11) Amenities at Sand Haven Campground are available during posted hours only. These hours are subject to change at the discretion of Sand Haven Campground.
- 12) Modifying, releasing air, causing damage, disconnecting, or any cause of damage to any of the amenities is strictly prohibited and grounds for immediate removal.
- 13) Please notify Sand Haven Campground of any cleaning needed or damages in the Shower House. The Shower House may be closed for public use in the face of communicable disease outbreaks.
- 14) No explosives or illegal substances are permitted to be kept by a Campers(s) at their Campsite. This includes fireworks.
- 15) Camper(s) must maintain campsites in a clean and neat manner. Only furniture or items designed for outdoor use are permitted in the outdoor area of the Campsite. This includes washing of decks and RV's as needed.
- 16) Sand Haven Campground reserves the right to direct campers to remove any article of personal property from the campground.
- 17) Camper(s) are responsible to keep their Campsite clean and orderly. For Seasonal Campers this includes mowing and trimming of the lawn at their Campsite. All grass clippings shall be disposed of in the proper location designated by Sand Haven Campground. Should Sand Haven Campground have to mow a site a \$50.00 fee will be charged to the Camper(s).
- 18) Tarps and pallets are not allowed. Should they be needed on a temporary basis please contact Sand Haven Campground for permission.
- 19) Sand Haven Campground will not accept packages or mail on behalf of Camper(s) unless permission is granted ahead of time on a per-basis approval.
- 20) White lattice skirting is required and must be completed within 60-days of the Camping Unit placement on the seasonal Campsite. If any other material is desired, written approval from Sand Haven Campground is required.
- 21) Sheets, blankets and/or tin foil are not proper window coverings and are not allowed.
- 22) Only one fire ring per Campsite is permitted. All firewood must be purchased on site or approved by Sand Haven Campground. Camper(s) are not permitted to cut trees or break branches for a fire but are permitted to pick up brush of the ground for burning.
- 23) No fire rings or open flames are allowed on decks.
- 24) Deck flooring must be 8-inches or more off the ground. Deck must be built in 4-foot by 8-foot sections and pieced together.
- 25) Deck structures cannot be attached to the Camping Unit.
 - a) If the Campsite is less than 50' x 65" structures may not exceed 8'.
 - b) If the Campsite is 50' x 65' deck structures may not exceed 12' long.
- 26) Railings are required for any deck 21" or more off the ground.
- 27) Deck must be at least 10-feet from the next Campsite and/or Camping Unit.
- 28) A single storage shed of vinyl resin is allowed but may not exceed 8' x 8'.
 - a) If the Campsite is 50' x 65' storage sheds may not exceed 8' x 10'.
- 29) Block patio construction cannot exceed the length of the Camping Unit and is considered a permanent improvement and may not be removed.
- 30) Casita or screen house construction is allowed with approval of material from Sand Haven Campground.
- 31) Cooling devices such as full/apartment sized refrigerator may not be placed unsecured outside of the Camping Unit. They must be placed inside a locked storage device/container. Dorm room sized refrigerators are allowed outside of a container if they can be independently locked. All outdoor refrigerators must remain locked while not attended.
- 32) Individual outside antennas in connection with radio, television, satellite, or CB's must be attached to the Camping Unit and cannot exceed 10 ft in height. No posts or additional modifications for the purpose of mounting one the listed items without written consent from Sand Haven Campground.
- 33) Camper(s) and their guest(s) agrees to abide by the provider's Acceptable Use Policy when using provided internet.
- 34) Fire department regulations require all walkways and common storage areas to be kept free of all personal belongings.

- 35) Tampering with any Fire Alarm Monitoring devices is a felony and may result in legal charges. Sprinkler heads must be free from any obstructions (no less than 24 inches in all directions as per Fire Code). Failure to comply may result in water damage & malfunctioning sprinklers and all expenses will be charged back to Camper(s).
- 36) Camper(s) agree to turn off water to Campsite when leaving the campground for a period of 12 hours or longer.
- 37) Each Campsite is supplied with a Back Flow Preventer on the water spicket as required by law. These are owned by Sand Haven Campground and shall not be altered in any way. Please regularly inspect the Back Flow Preventer and report any damages to Sand Haven Campground immediately. Fines received by the State of Wisconsin due to a missing Back Flow Preventer will be charged to Camper(s) and can be considered grounds for removal.
- 38) A white food grade hose must be used to connect water to the Camping Unit. The campground well waters is tested annually by the State of Wisconsin and at the discretion of Chippewa County Public Health Inspector. Sand Haven Campground water is certified safe for use as portable water for human consumption.
- 39) Camper(s) are to have their sewer hard piped per Department of Health and Human services. Any ground disposal of drain water (gray or black) is illegal and grounds for immediate removal.
- 40) Sand Haven Campground treats well water with a Commercial Water Softening System. This system is scheduled to regenerate during off peak hours, but may generate at times of high demand. During regeneration periods, soften water will not be available and may turn fixtures orange. This may require additional cleaning or specialized cleaning chemical. Please contact Sand Haven Campground with any concerns.
- 41) All water hoses must hook up to brass vacuum breaker (provided by Sand Haven Campground). Brass vacuum breaker must not be removed.
- 42) All dump valves must remain closed when not dumping.
- 43) Camper(s) agree to abide by all current and future recycling laws.
- 44) Camper(s) will dispose of all trash in proper receptacles in closed plastic trash bags.
- 45) All cardboard boxes must be broken down and disposed of in the proper receptacles.
- 46) Trash receptacles are limited to waste created at Sand Haven Campground. Bringing waste from outside of Sand Haven Campground for the purpose of dumping is subject to \$100 fine per item.
- 47) No person is permitted to perform maintenance work unless authorized in writing from Sand Haven Campground. Work that requires a Wisconsin's Contractor license must be performed by a qualified trades person with a license and approved by Sand Haven Campground.
- 48) Any landscaping or other improvements done to the Campsite by the Camper(s) shall remain at the Campsite after the Camper(s) vacate the site.
- 49) Alterations, mounting, or additions to the white vinyl fencing are not allowed.
- 50) Two vehicles are allowed per Campsite. Vehicles include any automobiles, pickup trucks, vans, motorcycles, boats, trailers, or street legal motor vehicles. Only vehicles under 9,000 pounds are allowed. Bicycles and other pedal vehicles are permitted and do not count towards this limit but must be stored in a respectable manner.
- 51) Parking will be assigned at the discretion of the Sand Haven Campground. Unregistered vehicles or vehicles parked in unassigned locations are subject to immediate impoundment at the vehicle owner's expense. The Camper(s) is responsible to have visitor's park at their assigned Campsite.
- 52) Sand Haven Campground will not allow inoperative or abandoned vehicles, vehicles with expired license plates, or vehicles that have not moved in 14 days to remain on the property. They will be subject to immediate impoundment at the vehicle owner's expense.
- 53) When entering and leaving the premises, operate your vehicle at a speed not to exceed five miles per hour. This will be strictly enforced.
- 54) Absolutely no vehicles are allowed on the common lawn areas at any time. No parking in striped off areas or tow away zones. Any damage caused by a Camper(s) and/or guest's vehicle shall be charged to the Camper(s). Non-Campsite parking is available in designated overflow parking.
- 55) Parking in overflow parking may not exceed 72 hours without written approval.
- 56) If Camper(s) wish to sell a Camping Unit, Camper(s) must first notify Sand Haven Campground. Before signing any purchase agreement, Camper(s) must obtain approval from Sand Haven Campground. If Camper(s) sell a Camping Unit without obtaining approval of the buyer, their agreement is terminated, and the Camping Unit is subject to removal. If Sand Haven Campground approves the buyer, the buyer must execute an agreement in their own name and pay any fees prior to staying at the Campsite.
- 57) "Dry Winter Camping" (water in/waste out) may be allowed on an occasional or special event basis. Sand Have RV Park reserves the right to limit or refuse occupancy of any type in the off season. Full-time winter camping is not permitted.
- 58) Camper(s) shall vacate on or before 11:00AM of the last day of the Rental Agreement.
- 59) In the case of severe weather, no storm shelter is located onsite. It is at the Camper(s) discretion to monitor the weather.
- 60) Local radio stations for weather alerts include 99.1 Rice Lake and WAXX 104.5 Eau Claire.
- 61) For Chippewa County Sheriff Non-Emergency call (715) 726-7701
- 62) In the event of a medical emergency and/or accident, permission is herein granted to allow for emergency medical treatment. Permission includes treating for minor injuries and/or to call for emergency services and to transport to a hospital. In consideration of the foregoing, Camper(s) hold harmless from any litigation and/or costs involved, Sand Haven Campground, its owners, employees, and agents, who may render assistance.
- 63) For fire and other emergencies call "911" or use the emergency red phone located by the pond.
- 64) If a maintenance emergency (such as no heat, lights, water) occurs after normal business hours please call the Sand Haven Campground phone number (715)967-2067. If the number is abused, Camper(s) will be charged a fee.

Failure of the Camper(s) to observe and fulfill any of the above Rules and Regulations shall constitute a breach of the Rental Agreement. This is a legal binding document, and you are encouraged to seek legal counsel if you do not understand any of the terms.
